



Placement Test Frequently Asked Questions College Credit Plus Students (formerly PSEO)

I completed the essay portion of the test, but I received a "Score Pending" result. What does this mean?

- Occasionally, the scoring mechanism needs additional feedback from a human reader to verify the appropriate score. If you receive the "Score Pending" result, a final writing score will be available in 24 hours. A printed score report will be mailed to you. You should receive the report in 2-3 days, depending on mail delivery in your area.

What do I do now?

- When the Records Office has received all required documents (including today's Accuplacer test scores), you will receive notification **in writing** of acceptance or denial to participate in the College Credit Plus program.

When can I register for fall semester classes?

- CCP students who plan to enroll in a Southern State course offered at one of our campus locations must meet initially with one of the specific advisors to register. You will receive more information with your acceptance letter. Fall Semester registration for new students begins April 15.

What should I do with the score report that the proctor gave me?

- Keep this report for your records.
