**Principals Report**

Mr. Iles reported on the MS/HS. He would like to recognize Ms. Allison Bach-Oliver, Ms. Kari Emory, Mr. Travis Bogart, on end of course testing. Other successful programs Mr. Iles recognized was the Day of Giving, Veterans Day, Father/Daughter Dance, to name a few. Had 17 students at CTC night. Mr. Iles thanked Deanna Risner and Allison on getting the Spirit Store up and running. It is helping support a positive climate/culture at the MS/HS. Winter sports in full swing. Local Seals for graduation is done; ODE is to release expectations soon – working with other area schools to have similar framework. 32 students are signed up to go to Washington DC. Career Day coming up on January 17, 2020. Mr. Iles also expressed appreciation for the donor who has donated over \$10,000 to the school for supplies and equipment.

Mr. Bick reported on the Elementary School and handed out a written report. 61% of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students passed the reading portion of the AIR Test. Bright Elementary was the highest of the area schools. Those students who passed will go to see a movie in Hillsboro. Cross Categorical unit students will go to the movies, as well. New Science texts will be one of the focus discussions of the in-service meeting. New interactive boards have been installed – working on training for the staff to utilize the technology in the classroom.
