Job Objective:

Provide psycho-educational assessments, program planning and consultation services that are consistent with the districts mission and mandated requirements.

Performance Responsibilities:

- Advocates for children. Initiates referrals to community resources as needed
- Refers district policy questions to administrators
- Advances the district professional image. Maintains open effective communications. Uses problem solving techniques to tactfully address questions/concerns
- Provides consultation and therapeutic intervention service. Obtains informed consent before providing services. Helps family/student understand how services relate to educational program
- Collaborate with other staff. Shares knowledge and resources that enhance student learning
- Monitors education laws, rules, and regulations.
- Prepares the assigned assessment [consultation area. Requisitions supplies as needed
- Serves as a resource to classroom teachers. Helps resolve problems which impede student participation in appropriate learning activities/ environments

- Develops and implements protocols to safeguard student assessment results that are shared with staff and/or referral sources
- Participates in differentiated referral system that allow staff and parents to request a multifaceted evaluation (MFE) and/or consultation for non-disabled students
- Complies with federal/state policies and procedures for the education of students identified as having a disability. Works with staff to ensure that services are provided in the least restrictive environment. Participates in due process procedures as requested
- Coordinates the multi-faceted evaluation process. Meets mandated paperwork timelines. Helps the intervention assistance team (IAT) prepare an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) for students meeting eligibility requirements. Participates in parent/ student conferences
- Participates in manifestation determination and functional behavioral assessment meetings. Helps staff implement behavior management plans. Provides ongoing communication and support for teachers
- Consults with staff to facilitate the early identification of mental health risk
- Documents observations of students in classroom settings
- Helps staff and families address student concerns (e.g., academic difficulties, excessive absences, behavior mental/physical health, family/peer relations.)
- Helps develop and implement strategies to improve grade, reduce suspensions, and improve graduation rates for at-risk students
- Maintains positive learning environment
- Participates in staff meetings, conferences, and other required school activities
- Maintains confidentiality of privileged information
- Reports suspected child abuse and/or neglect to civil authorities as required by law
